

## BlackJack



Blackjack is one of the most popular casino games and most guests are familiar with Blackjaor similar game called Pontoon. Gaming Nites uses 6 decks of cards for Blackjack, and the cards are dealt out of a 'shoe'. The object of the game is to beat the dealer by having a total that is closer to 21 than the dealer – without 'busting'.

Picture cards have the value of 10, aces have the value of 1 or 11 and other cards count as face value. A Blackjack is an ace and any 10 value card on the first two cards. Blackjack pays 3 to 2. For example, Blackjack a \$50 bet will pay \$75.

If you don't get dealt Blackjack you can draw additional cards until you decided to stand or you 'bust'. The dealer must hit on 16 or less and stand on 17 or more. If the dealer goes over 21, and has 'too many' they will pay all the remaining bets on the table. If you have a total closer to 21 than the dealer, or the dealer busts, you are paid even money.

Doubling – You can double your bet if your first two cards total 9,10 or 11 without having an ace.

Splitting – You can split your hand, to form two separate hands, if your first two cards have the same value. If you split aces you only get one additional card on each. If Aces are split and you are dealt a 10 value card, it is not Blackjack but 21 and is paid even money.
